Reading @CCJ

All year groups from 3-5 have been given a new yellow reading record that they should use at home and school each day. Please try and listen to your children read at least three times per week and sign the record each time.

Once a week, your child's reading record will be looked at by the class teacher. In the classroom children will be heard read by their class teacher each week in guided reading using a text suitable to their ability. This time with your child is invaluable not only to help with their early reading skills but to discuss books and how writers use a variety of techniques. In year 6 and in Kingfisher Class we are trialling an online system called *Reading Rewards* to track children's progress. On November 22nd we will offer parent workshops in order for you to support your child's reading at whatever stage they are. If you have any reading queries please see our English Leader, Mrs Milne.

School Council



Many of you will not be aware that our boiler was over 20 years old and was breaking down regularly but would cost £90,000 to replace. So it is with great delight that I can let you know that after two years of campaigning the Local Authority, they agreed to support the school with this cost and have fully funded a complete replacement of our heating and kitchen water heater. The work started in July and is due to be complete by the end of September, so on behalf of CCJ, I would like to say a huge thank you to the local authority as it is going to make the winter months far more cosy for our community!
