CCJ Parent Questionnaire and SIAMs Inspection

As a church school, a Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodists Schools (SIAMS) is conducted every 5 years. Our last inspection was October 2012 and we have recently been informed that we will be inspected again on Tuesday 10th October. To allow us to express the opinions of our community, we would like you to spare a few minutes and complete the questionnaire sent home as a paper copy and via text. Thank you to those parents who have already returned the form or completed it online. Please ensure all responses are in by Monday 9th October.

Reading and Spelling at CCJ

In both bands each class receives spelling homework each week, usually this will be based around a spelling rule plus additional words linked to the statutory spelling list. In your child's home learning book you should find a sheet of information about how the spellings are used and tested in school, you can also find this on the school website in the band pages. Learning the spellings regularly at home really helps to embed them in your child's writing and this is essential to their progress in English.

Please continue to ensure that you read regularly with your child at home. You should have a reading record coming home each day to record this in. The reading record is checked by teachers at school each week. All children will be heard read by the class teacher at least once during the week in guided reading sessions. Please note that Year 6 pupils do not have reading records as they are trialling an online reading journal completed at school each week. They should however come home with a reading book and bookmark to record their reading on.
