Last term we reported in the newsletter that our Governing body had ratified our Lock Down policy and procedure. We have spent a long time talking to and training staff in this procedure and will be practising with the whole school on Monday 4th December. The lockdown involves all of the children entering the nearest classroom, sitting in the book corner and having a class story or quiet game while the senior leaders ensure that the site is safe e.g. from loose dogs or foxes from the forest. The children will be run through the procedure in advance but may have questions at home. This will eventually become routinely tested like fire drills are already.


