A very big **welcome** to the three new children and their families that have joined us in Years 6, 4 and 3 this term – we hope you are enjoying being part of our community!





Credit Card Safety – BE AWARE!

We have been made aware of families in our community whose children have used their parents' bank or credit card details to purchase hundreds of pounds of online 'credit' or 'skins' on certain online games. PLEASE speak with you child if they play these games to ensure they are clear about the dangers of in-game purchases. PLEASE do not share your bank details or cards with children as it does not feel like real money to them. PLEASE remember that many of these games are unsuitable for children under the age of 15 or 18 and can include online chat facilities that are dangerous!
