PUPIL PREMIUM UNIFORM 2019/2020

At CCJ we are supporting families whose children have has free school meals by providing a school uniform package at the start of the academic year.

This package consists of:

- 2 x Jumpers or Cardigans**
- 2 x Polo Shirts**
- 1 x PE T-shirt.**

Order forms have gone home with children this week. Please can we ask that you complete this form and return it to the office by **21st June**. This is to ensure it is ordered and delivered before the start of Term 1.

If you are currently not in receipt of pupil premium or free school meal funding and think you may be entitled you can apply online <http://www.southglos.gov.uk/advice-and-benefits/benefits/free-school-meals/>.

At CCJ we provide a range of supportive provision using this funding. If you would like support filling out the application or advice on whether you may be eligible please see the school office.

Please note we only place ONE order per year for anyone who is entitled. If the form is not completed and returned by Friday 21st June, your child will NOT receive any uniform for the next academic year.

SPORTS DAY REMINDER!

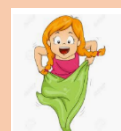
Don't forget Sports Day in next Tuesday!!

What is your child doing online?

Some of our children have recently undertaken a survey about online safety in order to raise awareness and inform our teaching. We thought you might like to see some of the results and discuss them with your child at home.



These statistics are taken from across years 5 and 6:

- 50% of children said they use the internet to play online with people they don't know.
- 58% of children said that they had shared photographs online. 71% of these children have shared a photograph that they now regret or are embarrassed by.
- 45% have lied about their age in order to access a specific website.
- 20% felt that they had been bullied online.

We believe that open and honest conversations are the best way to support our children in the digital world. For us, the most important aspect of being safe online is being able to recognise and report concerns and knowing that support is available. At school, we use the SMART rules to help us be safe online and we were really pleased to see that all of the children surveyed knew how to stay safe when using the internet.
