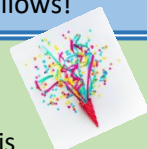


3DK Class Assembly

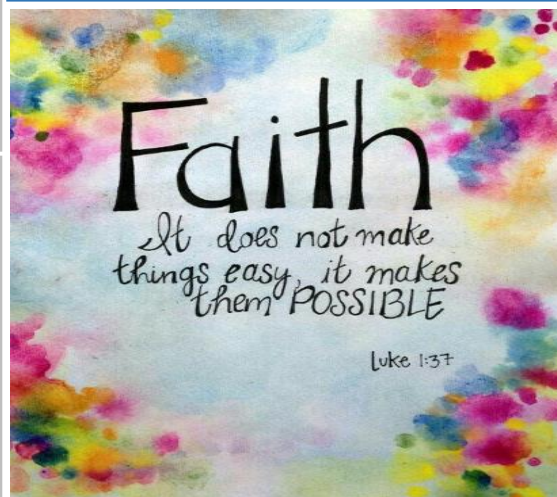


MEDICATION
