Multiplication Tables Check

This activity exactly mirrors the 'Multiplication Tables Check' that will be given to children at the end of Year 4. They are tested on their multiplication tables up to 12 x 12. There are twenty-five questions and children have six seconds to answer each question and three seconds between questions. The questions are generated randomly using the same rules as the 'Multiplication Tables Check' (see below). Results can be downloaded and printed at the end of the test. All year 4 children will be given a My Times Tables practice book to use and keep in school. Additional books are available to buy if you wish your children to practice at home. These can be purchased from your child's class teacher, at the book fair and during parents evenings. The cost of the book is £1
