Morning drop off

Please can I ask that all families remember that no children can be on the school site before 8.30am unless they are attending a morning club. This means that they must not be dropped off before 8.30am, nor leave home alone at a time that means they arrive before 8.30am. This is for the safety of your children who ARE NOT supervised until school opens at 8.45am. The gates often are locked until 8.30am and this means your children wait in a car park alone and this is unsafe. We will start contacting parents when children are dropped off early. Child Illness

A gentle reminder of our sickness and absence procedures. If your child is unwell you must contact the school providing full details by 8:30am. It is a legal requirement that for each day your child is unwell, the school must receive a daily phone call. In the event of sickness/upset stomach your child is unable to attend school for 48hours after the last episode. This is to stop contamination and spread of germs.

We currently have a pregnant member of staff; therefore, it is vital that you inform the school if your child has any of the following:

Rubella (measles) Chicken pox Slap cheek Hand, foot & mouth


We thank you for your cooperation and ask that you remind your children to wash their hands with soap and water regularly.
