Fresh Start

We launched our new 'Fresh Start' cycle on Monday and have been very pleased with how the children have responded to our the new behaviour system. We have already seen a reduction in the number of children visiting reflection at lunchtime to talk about behaviour that interrupts learning in class. In the small number of cases where children have had to go to another class this week and complete a 'fresh start' form, they have been able to discuss their behaviour with their teacher and this has helped them to think about changes they can make next time. We have also now started letting parents know if their child has been to reflection so that you can also talk to your child about how they can best move forward and make a fresh start.

The vast majority of behaviour at CCJ is excellent and children know exactly how to be ready, respectful and safe in school. We have had a great response from children to our competition to design a new 'positive postcard', which will be sent home to parents to let you know about excellent behaviour and work. We will be choosing a winner and letting the children see the chosen design next week!

Updated Attendance Policy

Thank you to the families who have supported our rule of no children on the school site before 8.30am unless they are attending a morning club. This is for the safety of your children. This week the CCJ Attendance Policy has been updated with Governors to include the following section.

Early Drop Off

Teaching and office staff are not officially employed to be on site until 8.30am and so no provision can be made for parents dropping their children off prior to this time. The playground gates will not be opened until 8.30am although no staff are on duty until the school doors open and school access starts at 8.45am. Every child remains under the care and safety of their parents or carers until 8.45am unless they are attending an early morning school club. The school will contact parents of children who arrive before this time to advise them that they have a legal obligation to provide safe childcare until 8.45am. The school reserves the right to charge a fee of £6 per 15 minutes per child if children are left at school unattended before 8.30am when the school playground opens. Parents will be encouraged to approach the Oldbury Court breakfast club who offer childcare provision for children from 8am daily.
