All you need is:

2 cups of plain flour

1 cup of salt

1 tablespoon of oil

half to 1 cup of cold water

2 drops of liquid food colouring

Mix the flour and salt then add the water, oil and food colouring. Knead the mixture well, adding a little more flour if the consistency is too wet.
