CCJ Clubs We offer a range of morning and after school clubs which are run by experienced professionals. All groups have the opportunity to perform at both the LTD summer/winter show and represent CCJ at festivals

Mudpie Explorers- Damon and his team focus on spending after school sessions in our lovely Forest School area where children have the opportunity to develop their knowledge of the natural world. They also get to learn a variety of new skills including tool use, rope work, fire lighting campfire cooking and more.

Premier Sports- Paul's clubs allow children to try a little bit of everything as well as help to develop their confidence and teamwork skills. Fun activities include ball games, dance, gymnastics, art and much, much more!
