### **School Timings**



- 8.30am Playground opens but children stay with parents
- 8.45am School doors open and children are dropped at the **Lower Band doors**
- 8.55am Register and lunch requests are taken in class
- 9.05am Registers close and any arrival after this time is recorded as late (L code)
- 9.15am- The late now becomes an unauthorised absence (U code) if a child arrives after this time
- 1.00pm- Afternoon registers are taken
- 3.20pm- School ends and pupils are collected from their classroom doors
