I am now in a position to share with you the very exciting but sad (for us) news that my incredible Deputy, Susan Friend, has been appointed as Head teacher in another school. While I know she is more than ready and will do an excellent job, we are obviously very sad that we will be saying goodbye to her as she leaves at the end of term 1. Throughout her time here, she has had an immense impact on teaching and learning, support for families, staff training, Governors, teaching classes and so, so much more that comes under the very big job description of a Deputy. We will say goodbye fully at the end of term but it is important that we share the news now so we can ensure a smooth handover for the families she works most closely with.

Yesterday, we created an intense and grueling day of interviews for four very strong candidates shortlisted from 28 applications. I am delighted to tell you that the strongest candidate was Alex Desmond, our current Y5/6 phase leader and so he will be starting this role, whilst still teaching Kingfishers, from November 1st. Mr Desmond is an excellent teacher but he is also an inspirational leader and within his role as phase leader, he has already made changes to reading, English, behaviour and culture that benefits every child. 
