
CCJ NEWS

Our CCJ Blended Learning Offer

As more schools around the country close classes, years or school due to a confirmed case, we know that despite our strong systems, it COULD happen here too. Therefore, we have worked together to create our CCJ blended learning offer for any child who cannot attend school due to COVID symptoms, waiting for a test or because their class is self-isolating.

We have also created a flow chart to help guide parents as to when children should isolate and when they should still come to school. If there are typical cold or flu symptoms such as sneezing, runny nose etc., they do not have to self-isolate but a temperature, persistent cough or change to taste/smell needs to be tested or they must self-isolate.
