Being Safe – Keeping Our Community Safe

As always we are looking at all of our systems to constantly review what we are doing to keep everyone safe and question if anything can be better. As a result, I am going to encourage you to consider whether your child can walk from the gates to their classroom without you from Monday. Teachers are on the doors and will be happy to hear from you if you need to communicate a message, equally any child who is feeling slightly wobbly will need you to take them to class. However, some children are able to happily and confidently say goodbye at the gates and walk into class to where their teacher is waiting to greet them. Please talk to your child/children about whether this is right for them as the less adults needing to walk round site, the safer we all will be.

In addition, to help with safety, you will see staff on the doors at the start and end of day wearing visors from Monday. This is because we need to have a visible reminder to everyone that we must stay socially distanced (2m) from anyone talking to us. If we do not do this then if a parent tests positive for COVID then our teacher will also need to isolate which means the bubble may have to close. We are not insisting that any parent wears face masks outside but anyone that does this will continue to give another level of protection to those around you.
