January Changes to Drop Off, PE, Forest Schools, Clubs and Lunches

Changes to Staggered Start and Finish Times

Following feedback from parents and carers, we will be changing our staggered start and finish times. We will now be organising the staggered times according to children's surnames. This should mean that where families have siblings in different classes, there will no longer be a 10-minute gap between drop offs and collections. As before, we will be asking some children to start school at 8:45am and some to start at 8:55am to reduce the number of people on site at the same time. There will also continue to be a 10-minute gap between collections at 3:10pm or 3:20pm.

Children's surnames beginning: A-L

8:45am arrival 3:10pm collection Children's surnames beginning M-Z 8:55am arrival 3:20pm collection

Please note: if the new start time/collection time is not possible due to work commitments or due to siblings attending other schools, please talk to your child's class teacher about your child switching to the other set of timings. The Infants are keeping their times of 8.40/8.50am and 3.05/3.15pm the same as they currently are.
