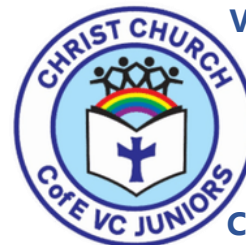
OUR CCJ PUPILS NEED YOU.....
