Flu Vaccines

The Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire Mass Vaccination Programme has asked us to share an update with you on the annual flu immunisation roll-out. Thank you for your patience in waiting for details for this year's flu immunisation programme. As you are aware, we were asked by NHS England to roll out the national COVID-19 vaccination programme for 12-15-year-olds in secondary schools from mid-September which meant a change to our planned timings for the Primary School Flu programme. We are confident that all 140,000 children in Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire will have been offered their flu vaccination by the end of January, which is the national target completion date. This means we are scheduling visits to primary schools from our teams from November through to 31 January

Reading at CCJ

We have made the decision to move away from physical reading records and will now be using Google Classroom as a way of monitoring children's reading at home. Each week, there will be an assignment called Reading Log that will be live from Fridays until the next Thursday. If your child has read 5 times at home throughout that week, all you need to do is press the submit/turn in button. You will not have to write a comment or attach any evidence. Your class teacher will then look at the assignment on Friday mornings and hand out a raffle ticket to those who have read 5 times. This will then be put into a raffle during Celebration Assembly where one ticket will be drawn and awarded with a book!
