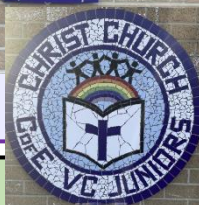


Term 2

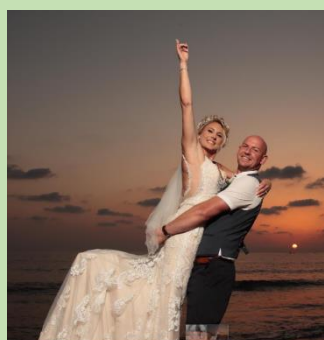
