Writing at CCJ

One of the highlights of my job is to see the work of children across the school and during this week I have seen more than 25 children for their incredible writing. What is brilliant to see is the level of effort that goes into every piece and also the clarity they have around their next steps. Every piece normally has purple pen showing where they have 'purple polished' which means that they have edited and improved their work demonstrating a remarkable growth mindset to strive to be even better.

There are several tools in books that are used to support children with understanding what their writing should include. One tool is the writing toolkits at the top of many pieces of extended writing. This lists certain features that been taught through short bursts of writing and reminds children which to include. Another tool which we introduced a couple of years ago is the writing check list at the back of all writing and curriculum books. This sets out all the objectives that children should be confident with by the end of Y3/4 or Y5/6. This means children can see what they are working towards and teachers can assess against this and plan opportunities for their classes. In the new year, we are really hoping to run a parent workshop to share more about English at CCJ with parents. Next week, all the Ignite schools will be meeting to share our ideas for writing. Miss Thackeray (English leader) and I are really looking forward to sharing our great writing practice but also hearing other ideas to 'purple polish' our writing provision even further! *Mrs Osborne*
