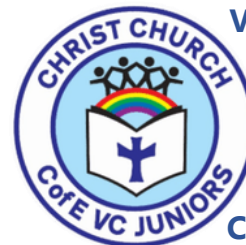

Be a positive role model, show them how even though something is hard we aren’t giving up, but will do our best and keep going.

School Council have decided to raise some money for Take 10 resources. They have chosen to have a Colour Hamper Raffle, Dress Down Day & Ice Lolly sale!

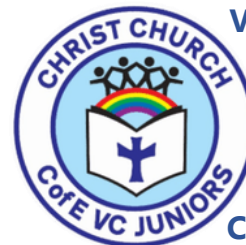
